Susan J. Schurman is Dean of the University College Community, director of Lifelong Learning in the Division of Continuing Education and Outreach, and professor in the School of Management and Labor Relations at Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey. She recently completed a decade of service as the founding president of the National Labor College. She earned BA and MA degrees from Michigan State University and a PhD. in Higher, Adult and Continuing Education from the University of Michigan where she served as Director of the Labor Studies Center while finishing her doctorate. She is a former president of the United Association for Labor Education and was recently elected president of the International Federation of Workers' Education Associations. She is presently a member of the Morris Brown College Board of Trustees and serves on several other non-profit boards. In her twenties she was the first woman elected president of a mass transit union. Her research is focused in two different areas: one stream centers on creating healthy and effective organizations; the second stream examines effective policies and practices that promote adult lifelong learning.
