

## **SOLIDAR members and their partners active on the ground**

All these organizations have released a call for funds to support their relief intervention operations in Haiti. You will find their bank account details here below.

**ACPP and Solidaridad Internacional** are coordinating relief action in Jacmel (South East, the second most affected city in the country but isolated from humanitarian aid until last Sunday 17th January) with their Haitian NGO partner CROSE (Coordination Régionale des Organisations du Sud-Est) and ATEPASE. Their current operations focuses on primary emergency action: water, basic medical equipment, blankets, tents, hygiene kits, cooking kits, etc. All supplies are being sent from Dominican Republic, either by road and boats. ACPP has a permanent staff on the field, in both Haiti and Dominican Republic, but their office in Haiti has been severely damaged by the earthquake. **MPDL's** staff in the Dominican Republic are also working on needs assessment to carry out emergency interventions. They are working in coordination with international institutions and NGOs on the ground to develop a strategic emergency plan to distribute basic goods to the population in the capital, Port-au-Prince, and other cities near the capital, especially those in areas where aid has not arrived yet. **ISCOS** is currently present in Republica Dominicana with its own staff and office together with CASC (trade union confederation in Republica Dominicana) which has started collecting and transporting basic items of humanitarian aid to Haiti. They are also trying to contact the Haiti trade unions CTH with whom they also work on co-operation activities. **The SOLIDAR Secretariat** has opened a separate bank account to collect contributions in support of Haiti, which we shall re-distribute among our members. The PES has launched a call to activists and partners, asking them to direct their donations in support to Haiti to SOLIDAR. Our Belgian members **FOS** and **Solidarité Syndicale Luxembourg** are organizing a fund collection to contribute to the SOLIDAR Haiti fund. Donations through FOS (for SOLIDAR in Haiti) are tax deductible.

**The ITUC** has launched a trade union appeal for earthquake-stricken Haiti, in cooperation with its regional organisations for the Americas, TUCA. Funds raised under the appeal will in the first instance be used to provide humanitarian assistance via the ITUC affiliates in the Dominican Republic, CASC, CNTD and CNUS. The three Dominican Republic organisations have opened up their local trade union offices to collect funds and essential items, which are being trucked across the border into Haiti, in cooperation with the ITUC's Haitian affiliate the CTH.
